

WORK STARTS ON YOUR NEW CHRISP STREET!

On 23rd August hoardings started to be installed around the north side of Crisp Street. The derelict buildings along Cordelia Street will be secured with hoardings in preparation for the demolition of Aurora and Clarissa Houses, the former Young Prince pub and Poplar Girls & Boys Club. Demolition of these buildings will start in October and is expected to take approximately three months.

Access to Crisp Street Market will not change. The entrance to Market Way from Cordelia street will remain open throughout the works, except for two potential days whilst the bridge unit in Market Way is demolished. We hope to do this work out of hours but during this time please look for the directional signage on the hoarding that will guide you into the Market.
